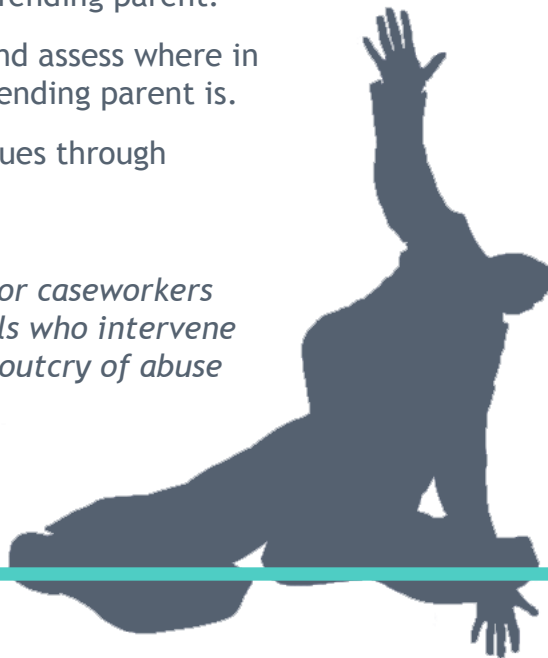


Initial Intervention with the Non-Offending Parent
